EXTERIOR OPPORTUNITIES

ADOPTION CENTER **\$1,000,000**

Over 10,000 visitors per year are expected at our Adoption Center. Prominent signage on the front of the campus structure and signage throughout included. Website and social media mentions for the life of the campus.

EDUCATION AND EVENT ROOM **\$250000**

From volunteer orientations to training classes to birthday parties, this room will be utilized constantly. With a glass door to a patio overlooking a pond and prairie, the space will be beautiful and peaceful. We also anticipate renting the space for outside groups in need of meeting space. Prominent signage will be outside the room and inside. Website and social media mentions for the life of the campus. Also, framed art of pets and/or your family is welcomed.

SPAY/NEUTER CLINIC **\$100000**

Performing 5,000 public surgeries a year, the Spay/Neuter Clinic is a bustling community resource helping to reduce the unwanted pet population. Prominent signage will be outside on the building as well as in the lobby. Also, framed art of pets and/or your family is welcomed.

INTAKE/LOST & FOUND **\$75000**

A separate prominent entrance for admissions and lost and found will direct our community to the help they need. Prominent signage will be outside on the building as well as in the lobby. Also, framed art of pets and/or your family is welcomed.

WALKING TRAILS **\$50000**

A favorite feature of the campus will be the walking trails throughout the prairie and wetlands. Prominent signage will be at the trailhead and on signs that will eventually be placed throughout the trails for humane education and to thank volunteers for walking dogs.

CATIO **\$50000**

When we first began discussions of this campus, the catio was a primary feature we wanted to incorporate. We believe the health and happiness of the cats in our care will increase exponentially with access to fresh air and sunshine. And we anticipate folks visiting just to see it from all over the south suburbs. Sponsorship includes prominent signage outside the catio and inside.

OUTDOOR MEET AND GREET **\$25000**

Dogs and their prospective family will get to know each other in this fenced-in area. We'll make it comfortable with dog-friendly benches and seating. Signage will be along the exterior fenceline and inside.

BARN **\$20000** **(4 - \$5,000 AVAILABLE -- 1 CLAIMED)**

Cook County sometimes rescues barn animals and we needed a temporary space to house them while they await transfer to rescue. On a regular basis, the barn will house TNR feral cats awaiting placement in barns/buildings through our Working Cat Program.

ADDITIONAL EXTERIOR OPPORTUNITIES

BRICK PLAZA

\$5000

The new campus will have an outdoor meditation garden and a memorial/tribute brick garden. This space will be available for naming and signage will be at the entrance.

OUTDOOR SEATING

\$2500/BENCH

(3 OF 10 AVAILABLE)

Dotting the exterior of the building will be benches for sitting with a dog or for families to take a rest with their visit. A small plaque will be indicate the donation and/or tribute.

INTERIOR OPPORTUNITIES

CAGELESS CAT ROOM

\$25000

A bright, airy space with proper ventilation will house our cats in a cageless environment. Prospective families will be able to meet and get to know cats for adoption. Comfortable, cat-friendly furniture will dot the room. Sponsorship includes signage inside as well as the opportunity for a framed artwork photograph if desired.

DOG ADOPTION ROOMS 1 AND 2 (2 AVAILABLE)

\$20000

Thousands of prospective adopters will walk through each of these rooms looking for their new family member. Sponsorship will include signage at the entrance of the room.

INDOOR MEET & GREET

\$5000

Winter and rain mean an indoor meet and greet room is important. This small room will be perfect for a dog and family to bond. Signage will be in the room.

INTERIOR CAT ROOMS (2 AVAILABLE)

\$5000

Off the main cageless cat rooms will be two smaller cat rooms which are available for adoption. Sponsorship includes signage inside.

KITTEN NURSERY

\$5000

Foster care is the primary method of caring for kittens at SSHS. But while they're awaiting foster, they need a space for care. Signage will be inside of the room.

FEATURED ADOPTION SUITE (1 OF 4 AVAILABLE)

\$5000

Small breed dogs, senior dogs, and bonded pairs will be featured in the modern and sleek adoption suites visible as one enters the lobby. We will also showcase dogs in foster who are available for adoption. Signage will be on the window near the door to each room.

VOLUNTEER CENTER

\$7500

Volunteers are a critical part of the campus and at our current shelter, they have nowhere to store their belongings and rest comfortably for a break. At the new campus, they'll have lockers, comfortable furniture, and a welcoming environment that speaks to how important they are to us all. Signage will be at the entrance to the room.

LOBBY RECEPTION

\$5000

The lobby reception desk will be visited by thousands and thousands of people annually. Signage will be on the desk indicating the sponsorship.

PUPPY ISOLATION ROOM

\$5000

While the Isolation room is not open to the public, the sponsorship of this room will save lives. SSHS will begin treating puppies suffering from parvovirus in house instead of at veterinary hospitals and this will save the organization a tremendous amount of money annually to be able to save even more. Signage will be inside the room.

BEHAVIOR PROGRAM KENNEL \$5000

Our Behavior Program Kennel space will house dogs that are going through our behavioral remediation program with our Behavior Coordinator and volunteers. They may be available for adoption but just not quite ready for the main adoption floor kennels. Signage will be inside of the room.

COFFEE STATION IN FRONT LOBBY \$2000

The new shelter will offer brewed coffee to guests furnished by Paying for Good, a vegan and fair-trade coffee company. A sponsorship sign on the kiosk will be displayed.

LOBBY BENCH SEATING \$1000

Our Front Lobby will be inviting and comfortable as people wait to meet pets for adoption or to process adoptions. The bench seating will have outlets for phone charging and will fit the interior design. A small plaque will be placed above the L shaped bench.

HIGHTOP TABLE (1 OF 2 AVAILABLE) \$500

The table and chairs is a comfortable space for filling out adoption questionnaires or processing adoptions. A small plaque will be placed on the table.

IDENTIFICATION KIOSK \$1000

Our identification tag machine will reside in an easy-to-use kiosk in the front lobby. A small plaque will be placed on the kiosk

KITCHEN/BREAK ROOM \$2500

For the first time in a long time, our staff will have a dedicated space to rest during breaks. We will also have kitchen facilities that will serve the Education and Training Room for events, etc. Signage will be inside the room.

CAT LAUNDRY AND KITCHEN \$2500

The new shelter will allow us to have efficient laundry and food preparation space for cats and kittens. Signage will be inside of the room.

DOG LAUNDRY AND KITCHEN \$2500

The new shelter will allow us to have efficient laundry and food preparation space for dogs and puppies. Signage will be inside of the room

EXECUTIVE OFFICE \$5000

The SSHS Executive Office not only houses the office space for our CEO but will be a small meeting space for internal and external meetings.

OPEN OFFICE SPACE \$2500

Our Foster Coordinator, Bookkeeper, and other future staff positions will utilize an open concept office space across from the featured dog adoption suites. Signage will be inside the space.

ADOPTIONS OFFICE \$2500

Our Adoptions and Office Manager office space also serves as a private adoption consultation space. Signage will be on the window looking into the office.

BATHING ROOM \$2000

Off our laundry area is a small bathing and grooming room for pets in need of a spruce up prior to adoption. Signage will be inside the room.

DOG HOLDING 1 AND 2 (2 AVAILABLE) \$5000

Incoming lost pets go into our Dog Holding Rooms as they wait for their owners or to be placed for adoption following their stray pet holding period. Signage will be outside of the two rooms.

24 HOUR DROP OFF VESTIBULE \$5000

Cook County Animal Control Officers and some area Police Departments pick up pets in the middle of the night. The vestibule will be a safe and climate controlled environment for officers to bring these pets in.

CAT ISOLATION \$5000

Cats with contagious illnesses will get treatment and be cared for in cages in Cat Isolation separate from the healthy cat population. Signage will be outside the room.

KITTEN ISOLATION \$5000

Kittens with contagious illnesses will get treatment and be cared for in cages in Kitten Isolation separate from the healthy kittens in Kitten Nursery. Signage will be outside the room.

PETSMART CAT HOLDING \$5000

SSHS has five PetSmart partners where our cats are housed for adoption in their 7-day-a-week Adoption Centers. Our partnership has been a huge success in placing more cats in homes and has strengthened our relationship with PetSmart Charities, the giving arm of PetSmart. Cats in this room are temporarily waiting to be transported to PetSmart. Signage will be outside the room.

MEDICAL CAT HOLDING \$5000

Cats with noncontagious medical conditions (for example, broken limb) will be cared for in this room as they await foster homes. Signage will be outside of the room.

DOG ISOLATION \$5000

Dogs with contagious illnesses will get treatment and be cared for in kennels in Dog Isolation separate from the healthy dog population. Signage will be outside the room.

SHELTER SURGERY HOLDING \$5000

This kennel room is where shelter and fostered pets recovering from their spay/neuter surgery in our Spay/Neuter Clinic will temporarily reside until they go back to the adoption floor or are picked up their foster family. Signage will be inside the room.

SPAY/NEUTER CLINIC EXAM ROOM \$2500

Spay/neuter patients will be seen by our veterinarian in this room just off the lobby. Signage will be inside the room.

SPAY/NEUTER RECEPTION DESK \$2500

The desk is located in the lobby of the Clinic and signage will be on the desk.

DRIVEWAY \$25000

The shelter campus is new construction on a gorgeous piece of land at 21800 Central Ave. A new driveway must be constructed to enter the shelter campus. Signage will be at the curve of the driveway coming onto the property.

LANDSCAPING (7 AVAILABLE) \$1000

The SSHS landscaping plan honors the surrounding landscape by utilizing native plants and prairie grass. Each landscaped section can be named with an engraved stone placed in the section.
